## **MENDIP SCOUT BASE**

## Getting to Mendip Scout Base Simplified


Mendip Scout Base is easily accessed from the M5, when travelling from the North, South, or West; alternatively, via Shepton Mallet and Wells, if coming from the East.

Address: Scout Hut, Combe Lane, Wedmore BS28 4DY

Use Post Code 'BS28 4DY' to find the Base by SatNav

## From the west via M5 motorway

- Leave the M5 at junction 22 and proceed to the roundabout on the A38.
- Take the 3rd exit A38 towards Bristol for about 0.1 miles.
- Shortly after the dual carriageway starts, turn right by the Fox & Goose Inn (signposted to Mark).
- Follow this road (Harp Road) for 1.8 miles until you reach a crossroad at the B3139.



- Turn left onto the B3139 (Mark Causeway) and follow it for 4.6 miles to Wedmore; passing through the villages of Mark and Blackford (watch out for numerous traffic calming measures).
- In Wedmore continue along the B3139 past the church, to the road junction adjacent to the Paper Shop.
- Turn right onto the main street, then up to the junction at the top of the street.
- Turn left (Wells direction) on the B3139 past the New Inn, and to the brow of the hill.
- Turn left into Combe Lane (unmade lane) Mendip Scout Base is the second turning on the right.

## From the east via the Salisbury Plain area

- Make your way to Shepton Mallet using the A36, A37, A303, A350 and/or A361.
- In Shepton Mallet look for, and follow, the direction signs for Wells (B371).
- Follow the A371 for 5.4 Miles, passing through Croscombe, and go straight across the large roundabout at Wells, to the second set of traffic lights, located at a 'T' junction.
- Turn left at these traffic lights (A371- Portway) and follow this road for 0.5 Miles.
- Take the left hand road (B3139 signposted to Wedmore) at the broad road junction, and follow it for 6.7 miles, passing through the village of Theale on the way.
- After passing the "Oncoming vehicles in the middle of the road" sign at Wedmore, turn right at the brow of the hill into Combe Lane Mendip Scout Base is the second turning on the right.
